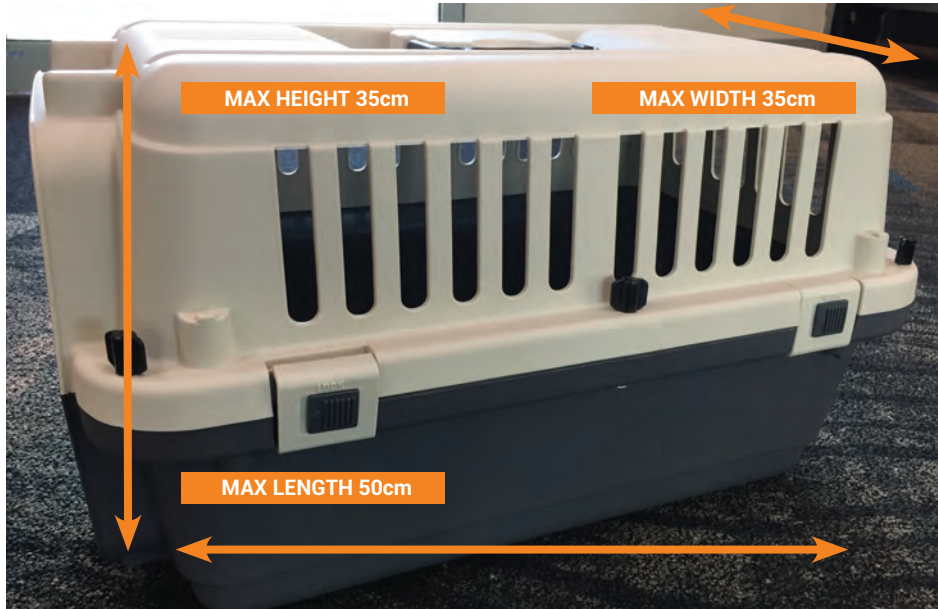




Transporting your pet with Sounds Air



On our Pilatus PC12 and Cessna Caravan aircraft we can take small pets in approved animal carriers. We are limited to only taking small pets as the space available in both aircraft is very limited.

- Please ensure you pre-book your pet.
- Please remember carriage of pets is subject to availability of space on the aircraft.
- Strapping/taping a cage is not an acceptable means of securing the cage and will not be accepted by Sounds Air.
- The cage must be latched by a two step method e.g. screw and latch.
- Soft cages/boxes will not be accepted.
- Cages that do not meet the requirements will not be accepted for travel.



When purchasing a carrier – ensure that it meets airline regulations. Your pet needs to be able to move around comfortably, with adequate ventilation.

Airport staff may cable tie the carrier as a secondary means of securing the cage. Cable ties must not be cut short or looped through ventilation holes – in line with IATA live pet transport regulations.

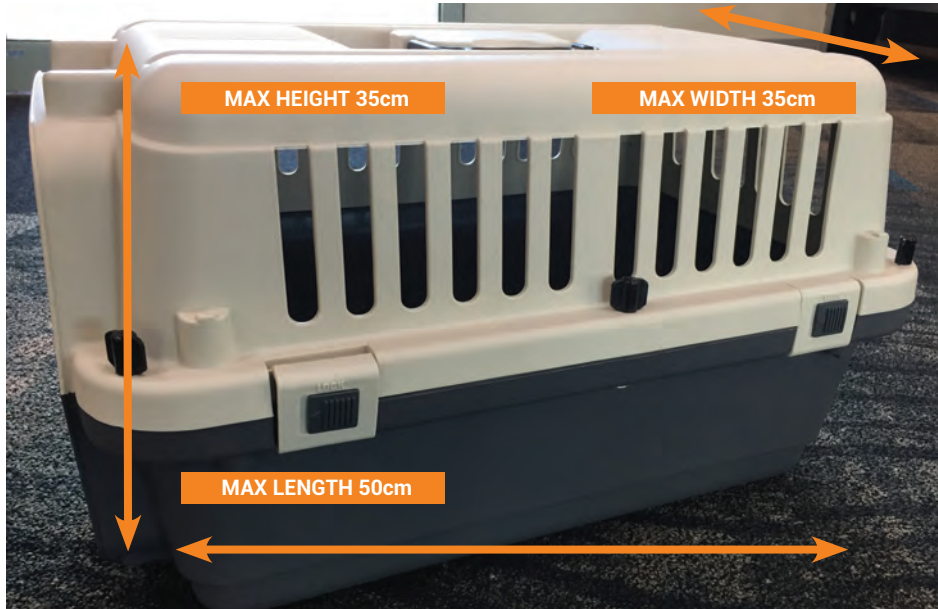

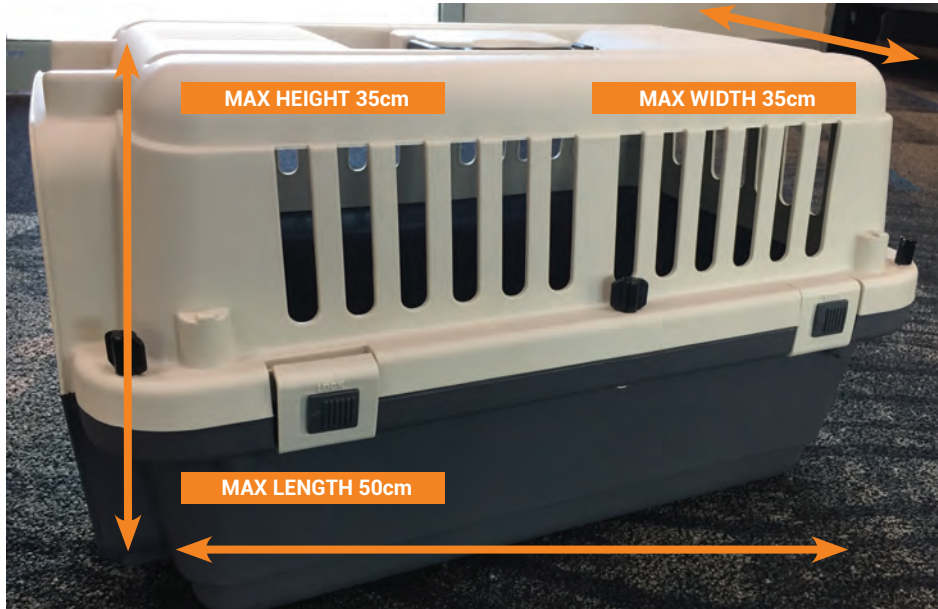

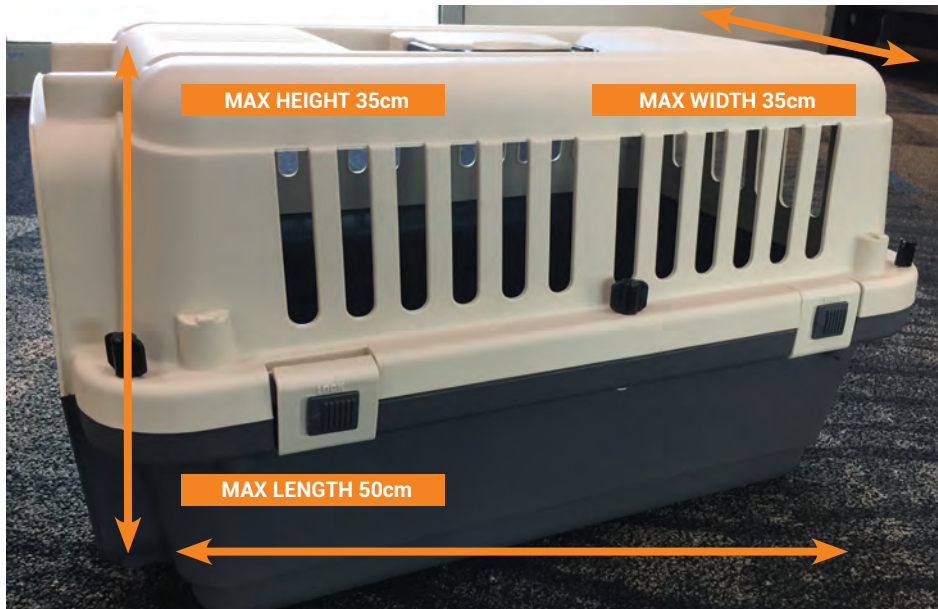
